Housebuilders do not landbank!


- The development process is complex

The Development Process










Site Acquisition Process

RISK

- The 'Planning' stage influences the risks and rewards associated with a site







Site Acquisition Process

- Option Land land which is considered to have longer term potential beyond the current Plan Period
- Conditional on Planning Contract


LDP Promotion

- Frontloaded system
- fffff
- 4-6 years to complete process
- If site is not allocated in Deposit LDP, experience confirms that it is very unlikely to be allocated
- Track record of undeliverable sites being allocated e.g. Caerphilly, RCT



- Site initiation 3-6 months
- Challenges
 - Lack of skills and labour
 - Lack of materials
 - Weather
 - Ecology Mitigation

Outline Application Submission (January 2016) Resolution to Grant (December 2016) S106 Agreement (29th April 2017) JR Period (6 weeks) Reserved Matters Preparation and Submission (produced whilst S106 was being signed) – 5th May 2017 Reserved Matters Approval and Pre Commencement Conditions (1st November 2017) European Protected Species Licenses – Bats and GCN (6 weeks) S 104 Agreement (January 2018) S278 Agreement (February 2017 - February 2018)

Part Commencement – February 2018 (the part of the site not requiring EPS GCN License)

10 homes delivered by June 2018, 50 -60 per year afterwards












Change v Certainty
